

Call for Site Proposal

Proposals are solicited for the International Conference on Systems Biology (ICSB) in the year 2003 and beyond. ICSB is a major conference in the field of systems biology. The first conference (ICSB2000) was held in November 2000 in Tokyo, with over 300 participants from around the globe. The second conference (ICSB2001) will be held at the California Institute of Technology (Pasadena, CA, USA) on November 4-7, 2001.

Those who are interested in hosting ICSB in 2003 and beyond may submit a site proposal in the following format.

SITE PROPOSAL FORMAT

1. Host institution
2. Conference organization committee
3. Financial plan
 - Expected number of participants (normal, student)
 - Registration fee (normal registration, student registration)
 - Conference organization cost (conference hall, cost for publicity (printed poster, etc.), invited speakers, network, proceedings, etc.)
 - Expected amount of donations from companies, etc. (exhibitions, etc)
4. Conference venue and city
5. Schedule proposal
 - Conference date
 - Various deadlines
 - Other schedule items

At this moment, all conference finances are managed by a stand-alone budget; i.e., the host institution will be fully responsible for all budget issues.
